Dr. Charles Mabry is in the private practice of general, vascular, and thoracic surgery in Pine Bluff, Arkansas, where he has been since 1982. He is from Arkansas and received his medical degree from the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences (UAMS) in 1975, where he also completed his five-year general surgery residency in 1979.

Dr. Mabry is board certified by the American Board of Surgery and is a Fellow of the American College of Surgeons (ACS), having been elected to Fellowship in the College in 1984. He is also a member of the Southern Surgical Association, the second oldest surgical educational organization in America. For nine years (2003-2011), he served on the Board of Regents of the American College of Surgeons.

Dr. Mabry has been involved with health care policy for over two decades, serving as a member of the ACS General Surgery Coding and Reimbursement Committee. He also has represented the ACS, as its advisor, for 20 years, on the AMA/Specialty Society Relative Value Update Committee (AMA RUC), which develops values for CPT codes.

Dr. Mabry is chairman of the ACS Health Policy Advisory Council and is a member of the ACS Health Policy Advisory Group, which is the main health policy oversight committee of the ACS.

Dr. Mabry is in the private practice of surgery in Pine Bluff at Jefferson Regional Medical Center, one of the state's Level II trauma centers, where he continues in a busy clinical practice of surgery with five other general surgeons.

Dr. Mabry currently holds the academic title of Associate Professor in the College of Medicine at UAMS and spends part of his time at UAMS in the Department of Surgery as the Practice Management Advisor to the Chairman, where he deals with academic practice management issues, coding & billing, and education of the residents in practice management issues.

Dr. Mabry has been married to Ruth for over 30 years and is the proud father of three children and five grandchildren. His hobby consists of spending what spare time he has with his family and watching them all grow up all too fast.
