HAZIM J. SAFI, MD, FACS

Hazim J. Safi, MD, is professor and founding chair of the Department of Cardiothoracic and Vascular Surgery for the McGovern Medical School at The University of Texas Health Science Center at Houston (UTHealth) in Houston, Texas, and chief of cardiothoracic and vascular surgery at the Memorial Hermann Heart & Vascular Institute.

Originally from Baghdad, Iraq, Dr. Safi has been a pioneer in various areas of cardiothoracic and aortic surgery procedures for more than a quarter century. After earning his medical degree, he held general surgery internships at Medical City Teaching Hospital in Baghdad and later at St. James Hospital in London, England. Following that, he traveled to Houston, where he completed his cardiothoracic residency at Baylor College of Medicine, under the mentorship of Dr. Michael DeBakey.

Dr. Safi's clinical interests include abdominal aortic aneurysm repair, acute aortic dissection, aneurysms, aortic root, aortic valve preservation, aortic valve surgery, ascending and arch aneurysm, coronary artery bypass and thoracoabdominal aneurysm repair.

Dr. Safi has authored or co-authored nearly 30 book chapters and more than 300 peer-reviewed articles for medical journals. He has also given more than 400 lectures to provide training for surgeons worldwide.

For his contributions, Dr. Safi has received many local, national, and international honors, from being named one of Houston's Top Doctor by *Houstonia* magazine to being inducted into the prestigious Academy of Athens in Greece. In 2020, he was presented with a Festschrift at the McGovern Medical School at UTHealth to commemorate and pay tribute to his advancements as a physician, contributions as an academic surgeon, and commitment to his family, co-workers, and patients.
