Dr. Papaconstantinou was born in Oak Ridge, TN and received an MD degree from the Baylor College of Medicine in Houston, TX. His general surgery training was conducted at the University of Cincinnati in Cincinnati, OH, and included two years of research at the University of Texas Medical Branch in Galveston, TX. He then completed a fellowship in colon and rectal surgery at the University of Minnesota in Minneapolis, MN. After his fellowship, he joined the staff at the University of Texas Southwestern in Dallas.

Dr. Papaconstantinou is certified by the American Board of Colon and Rectal Surgery and the American Board of Surgery. He specializes in diseases of the colon, rectum, and anus.

In his 21+ years of experience, Dr. Papaconstantinou has published over 97 peer-reviewed articles and book chapters on colorectal subjects, and he is a member of multiple medical societies. Dr. Papaconstantinou maintains a very busy academic and clinical practice. He is an active researcher but still finds time to educate medical students, surgical residents, and colorectal fellows. Dr. Papaconstantinou serves on the American Board of Colon and Rectal Surgery and American Board of Surgery.
